- You <u>MUST</u> Wear a Mask <u>at all times</u> when in the **Bar & Grill** <u>unless</u> you are <u>seated</u> at a dining table.
- **Tables** (indoor & outside) <u>MUST</u> remain 6 Feet apart and there <u>MUST</u> be <u>NO MORE than 6</u> Guests per table. <u>PLEASE DO NOT MOVE TABLES & CHAIRS</u> on the Patio or in the Bar & Grill!!!
- The Beverage Cart (Hours Will Vary & Weather Dependent).
- We will do our best to provide **food**, **beverages and snacks** as long as we can obtain the products from our vendors and **continue to sell them in a safe manner**.
- Golfers are welcome to bring their own **non-alcoholic beverages** and **food items** for consumption on the Golf Course (not on the patio or in the clubhouse.)
- **The Driving Range Hours of Operation** will be modified. 603-896-6500 *Please see the "Hours" Page of our web site for specific hours of operation.* **scottishhighlandsgolf.com**
- There will be No Ice & Water Machine Use in the Clubhouse.
- There will be **No Posting of Scores at the Computer in the Clubhouse**.
- There will be No Access to the Locker Rooms.
- Although the Clubhouse Lobby, Proshop, Restrooms & Range Building will be open, access will be restricted to one person at a time. *Everyone MUST wear a mask when entering the buildings*.

On the course you will notice:

- Foam Filled Cups for easy access to golf balls. We are asking you to leave the Flag Stick in the hole.
- **Carts can now be shared by two golfers.** We will continue to allow **individual cart use** for anyone that does not feel comfortable sharing a cart. Please let us know your preference and we will honor your requests based on availability.
- We will do our best to **sanitize the carts** between uses, but we are struggling with the same shortages of supplies as you may be.
- We will have an **additional chemical toilet in the parking lot.**
- We strongly urge our visitors to take personal care.
- Utilize personal distancing, do not handle other players clubs or golf balls, tap clubs or shoes at the end of the round rather than the customary hand shake. Wash hands frequently, use sanitizer often. We are trying our best to provide hand sanitizer but may not have any at times so visitors may have to bring their own.

And finally, if you are not feeling well, have recently visited a foreign country, have tested positive for the virus or live with someone who has or is showing symptoms, STAY HOME.
