We at Campbell's Scottish Highlands, truly appreciate your patronage.

It is course policy to restrict motorized golf carts to "Cart Paths Only" when weather or turf conditions warrant. This policy helps us ensure the safety of our customers and also the ability to provide the best possible playing conditions in the long term.

We recognize the needs of the disabled golfer who suffers from walking impairments or other conditions that would make it impossible for him or her to enjoy the golf course with restrictions on golf cart use.

When golf carts are restricted to "Cart Path Only", our golf shop staff members will provide golfers covered by the ADA with an identifying flag to display on the golf cart they are riding in or operating.

In general, this flag will allow the disabled golfer to access areas of the golf course that others cannot. In addition to allowing the disabled golfer to leave and return to the cart path at designated points at each hole, the GPS system allows us to open up more areas of travel for the handicap golfer. If you begin to enter a restricted area (due to risk of dangerous ground conditions), the GPS Screen will warn you (with beeps and a written message). Please pay attention to the GPS screen. Please address any questions or concerns with the golf shop attendant for clear understanding of the flag policy.

Please understand that this golf cart traffic is likely to adversely affect turf and soil, as well as playability. We appreciate your cooperation in using care and exercising good judgement.

Please Note: Whether the Cart Path Rule of the Day is "Cart Path Only" or "90 Degrees" some restrictions from dangerous areas such as hillsides and woods or easily damaged areas such as tees, fairways, and greens may apply.

Golfers with disabilities that wish to be given a flag must identify themselves to the golf shop staff at check-in.

Consistent with government rulings on the ADA, we reserve the right to restrict all golf cart traffic in rare instances when excessive heat, moisture stress, new turf, other weather related or maintenance related conditions create extreme safety issues or would result in any cart traffic causing excessive turf damage. If at any time it is apparent these conditions might exist, we suggest calling ahead.

Although we make every effort each morning to set a "cart path rule of the day", extreme weather events can give us cause to change the rule at any time during the day.

Any use of golf carts on or off of the paths is at your own risk, and any problems or injuries resulting from such use is the golfer's responsibility. For safety reasons we strongly discourage the use of golf carts on severe slopes or through tall grass areas. Please avoid these areas with the golf carts.
