

Dear Golfers,

We are happy to see you here at Campbell's Scottish Highlands Golf Course.

It has been a challenging year for all of us and continuous changes to COVID-19 Guidelines will present some challenges ahead. We will do our best to keep you informed of new developments that may affect your event in which you are participating.

We have developed the following information as **Guidance for Golfers in Tournaments** as we continue to navigate through the COVID – 19 Pandemic. ***Our hope is that we're able to return to more normal tournament operations over the course of the season*** but those decisions will be made based on public health as well as CDC, New Hampshire HHS, and state government directives. Our goal is to provide a safe environment for all of your tournament golfers, tournament volunteers and CSHGC Staff.

Tournament Guidelines, Policies & Procedures

If any golfer is not feeling well, has tested positive or lives with someone who has tested positive or is showing symptoms, PLEASE STAY HOME. If any golfer develops symptoms during the tournament, PLEASE GO HOME.

- Golfers should maintain six (6) feet of distance between themselves and other golfers.
- Golfers must wear a mask (over the mouth and nose) **outdoors** when **social distancing is not possible**.
- Golfers must wear a mask (over the mouth and nose) when **inside any building** on the premises.
- Golfers should avoid touching their mouth, nose, lips and eyes.
- Golfers should wash their hands frequently or if are unable to wash their hands, should use hand sanitizer.
- Golfers should refrain from shaking hands prior to and following the round.

Pre-Round

- The **Driving Range and Putting Greens** will be open and **social distancing and mask guidance should be followed**.
- Golfers are asked to arrive at the course no more than 15 minutes prior to the tournament start time unless planning to practice at the Driving Range, Putting Green or make merchandise or food/beverage purchases in the clubhouse prior to the tournament start time.
- Golfers should listen to any announcements being made for directions concerning cart location. CSHGC Staff will place the names of golfers (pairings) on the carts as well as scorecards and pencils. Signage in the Parking Lot will indicate the starting holes for each group of carts.
- The Clubhouse, Pro shop, Restrooms and Bar & Grill will be open but golfers must abide by state-mandated policies on social distancing. Everyone **MUST** wear a mask (over the mouth and nose) when entering the building and must remain masked while in the building (unless seated at a table eating or drinking).
- **No congregating** in the clubhouse, in the parking lot or on the patio. Other than entering the clubhouse for restroom use or purchases of food, drink or merchandise, or use of the putting green, golfers should remain in their cars until they can proceed to their assigned carts just prior to the tournament start time.
- **Rental Clubs** – per order of NH State, Rental Clubs are not available at this time.

During Round

- **Carts** - Walking is encouraged, however double occupancy or sharing a cart by same household members is permitted. *Non-household members riding in the same cart should wear cloth face coverings over their noses and mouths when riding in the cart and within 6 feet of each other.*
- **On the Tees** - No more than four golfers are allowed on a tee at one time. If more than one foursome is assigned to a tee, the golfers **must not congregate** but **must maintain six (6) feet of distance between themselves and other golfers.**
- **On the Course** - Regardless of their position on the golf course all golfers must maintain six (6) feet of distance between themselves and other golfers. This includes when they are preparing for a shot, walking down the fairway/rough, on the teeing ground, on the putting green, and all other locations.
- **Flagsticks** - Leaving the Flag Sticks in the holes is encouraged.
- **Scorecards** – Pencils and Scorecards will be pre-distributed by CSHGC staff and can be found attached to the steering wheel of one cart per foursome. Please **designate a scorekeeper within each foursome.** All golfers should communicate clearly with the scorekeeper to ensure accurate scoring.
- **Weather Delays** - Should play be suspended (by 3 consecutive horn blasts) for inclement weather, players **MUST** seek shelter in their cars. **A signal to resume play will be indicated by 1 horn blast.**

Post Round

Scoring – at the end of the round, the **designated scorekeeper for each foursome** should turn in the team's scorecard to the staff in the CSHGC Proshop. The CSHGC staff will inform the Group's Tournament Coordinator upon determination of winners.

Prizes & Awards – The Group's Tournament Coordinator is responsible for notification and distribution of all prizes/awards. This may be done on the premises with social distancing guidelines being followed or off the premises at a later date and time arranged between the Tournament coordinator and winners.

Food & Beverage – The Bar & Grill will be open for individual purchases.

- *All golfers must comply with NH State mandated guidelines for the Food Service Industry.*
- Golfers **MUST** wear a mask at all times when in the Bar & Grill unless seated at a dining table eating/drinking.
- Tables (indoor & outside) **MUST** remain 6 Feet apart and there **MUST** be **NO MORE** than 10 Guests per table. In order to maximize seating per the State Guidelines **we kindly ask that you DO NOT MOVE TABLES & CHAIRS on the Patio or in the Bar & Grill!**
- Current NH restrictions (6 Foot Rule and 10 Guest Rule) allow for 34 seats indoors and 72 outdoors.
- The Beverage Cart will be available to golfers during tournaments.
- Golfers are welcome to bring their own non-alcoholic beverages and prepackaged snack items for consumption on the Golf Course (not on the patio or in the clubhouse.)

Food Service (for Tournament Groups)

Due to current NH restrictions, we cannot currently provide buffet service or sit-down meals.

Your Tournament Coordinator should inform your group of the food choices made for the group which may include coupons for food on the turn and/or sandwiches delivered during play.
