Dear Golfers,

We are happy to see you here at Campbell's Scottish Highlands Golf Course. It has been a challenging time for all of us due to continuous changes to COVID-19 Recommendations. We will do our best to keep you informed of new developments that may affect your event in which you are participating.

We have developed the following information as **Recommendations for Golfers in Tournaments**. We are fortunate that *we've been able to return to more normal tournament operations*.

Our goal is to provide a safe environment for all tournament golfers, tournament volunteers and CSHGC Staff.

Tournament Guidelines

If any golfer is not feeling well, has tested positive or lives with someone who has tested positive or is showing symptoms, PLEASE STAY HOME. If any golfer develops symptoms during the tournament, PLEASE GO HOME.

- ➤ Golfers should maintain six (6) feet of distance between themselves and other golfers.
- > Golfers should wash their hands frequently or if are unable to wash their hands, should use hand sanitizer.
- ▶ Golfers should refrain from shaking hands prior to and following the round.

Pre-Round

- The Driving Range and Putting Greens will be open and social distancing should be followed.
- Golfers should listen to any announcements being made for directions concerning cart location.
- CSHGC Staff will place the names of golfers (pairings) on the carts as well as scorecards and pencils.
- Signage in the Parking Lot will indicate the starting holes for each group of carts.
- Please maintain **social distance**. Please do not congregate in large groups

During Round

- On the Course Regardless of their position on the golf course, all golfers should maintain six (6) feet of distance between themselves and other golfers.
- Weather Delays Should play be suspended (by 3 consecutive horn blasts) for inclement weather, golfers are encouraged to seek shelter in their cars. A signal to resume play will be indicated by 1 horn blast.

Food & Beverage -

- The Bar & Grill and Patio will be open for individual food and beverage purchases as well as any food service ordered by the Tournament.
- The Beverage Cart will be available to golfers during tournaments.
- Golfers are welcome to bring their own **non-alcoholic beverages** and **prepackaged snack items** for consumption on the Golf Course (not on the patio or in the clubhouse.)
